Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal is a reputed private aided autonomous college with 'A' grade from NAAC, in the city of Bhopal. This College has maintained its disposition for the last 45 years, as a center for all-round education based on discipline, duty, devotion and innovative teaching and has an excellent academic reputation. The primary objective of this institution is to promote women's empowerment through value based education. All team members observed with satisfaction the discipline and devotion of its students and staff.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college has fecilitated the process for autonomous status of the institution. UGC, New Delhi granted Autonomous status from the session 2018-19 in December 2017. Subsequent to NOC from department of Higher Education, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh and by Barkatullah University, Bhopal the Autonomous status was conferred for 10 years after all necessay approvals. College commenced requisite process and procedure as laid down by the UGC guidelines 2018 for establishing the Autonomous Cell of the college. College is a multi faculty college with four faculties under the umbrella of autonomy viz. Arts, Science, Commerce, Computer Science and Application.

On the onset, during the first year of Autonomous Cell, the Board of Studies of all the 18 subjects in the faculty of Arts, Science, Commerce and Computer Science & Application were constituted as per the UGC guidelines. Academic council, finance committee and Governing Body Council were also constituted. Barkatullah University has nominated their members for all the committees in line with the guidelines of the University. In every Board of Studies, one nominee from Barkatullah University, one member from other university, head of the department of the concerned subject and all faculty members of the department were the members. One representative from industry/corporate sector/ allied area relating to placement and one meritorious alumna of the department were nominated by the Principal. Two subject experts were nominated by the Academic Council of the college.

Meetings of all the 18 Board of Studies were convened during the period Oct-01-2018 to Oct-15-2018. For this session the college adopted the syllabus of Central Board of Studies as approved by Deartment of Higher Education and Barkatullah University. The examination pattern and the marking scheme in each subjects of UG first year & PG I and II semester were kept same as that of Barkatullah University.

The meeting of the Academic Council was held on 31.10.2018. The minutes of the Boarth of Studies were approved by academic council. College adopted the "Non Conventional" mode of evaluation for the year 2018-19 in PG-I & II Sem, UG I year in CCE (Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation) examination. It was also decided that from next year college will start certificate course for 3 months or 6 months duration in Department of Home Science, Botany and Music. Academic calendar for the session 2018-19 was also prepared and was approved by the council. College adopted the prototype of 3 sections, of objective type, short answer and long answer as practiced in UG courses, for the PG courses as well.

Autonomous Examination Cell conducted the first examination for PG I Sem in the month of Nov-Dec 2018 in eight subjects with 35 papers. The examination process began with examination forms submission by students in the month of Nov 2018. Students paid the examination fee through SBI collect, an online mode of payments. Exams were conducted from 11 days (7.12.2018-17.12.2018) in one shift. The TR and marksheets sent to Barkatullah University were validated with signature of Registrar, Barkatullah University. A meeting of examination committee was convened on 18.01.2019 to discuss the result and the result was declared on 29.01.2019 through the college website.

Further, college conducted the meeting of finance committee on 05.01.2019, to put before the committee, the first budget for the session 2018-19 for examination related expenditure and grant for other heads. Honourable members approved the proposed budget. Finance Ordinance of the college as per the rules and directives of UGC and Barkatullah University was also prepared and was approved.

A meeting of Governing Body Council was held on 12.01.2019. The council approved the minutes of the Boards of Studies of the 18 subjects after scrutiny. The minutes of academic council and finance committee were approved. The college is in proces of developing the MIS module for the examination cell of the Autonomous cell. It will be functional by the session 2019-20. MIS system will store the information of all the students admitted to the courses under the preview of the Autonomous scheme, examination details, TR sheets, Mark sheets etc.

The examination cell of the college also successfully conducted the PG 2nd semester and UG I yr examination from 15th March'19 to June '19. Result was declared in the month of June. Peer team Committee congratulated the examination cell for timely completion of the examination process.

Extra curriclar activities:-

College publishes its biannual research journal "Highbrow" with ISSN number and the college magazine "Divya" to nurture the budding talents of the institution. Most of the departments publish their departmental newsletters as well. College also has an in-campus hostel with all facilities for its 108 inmates and a rich library with 36,600 plus books, ejournals and e-books through Inflibnet, sports complex with gymnasium and separate activity center, canteen.
