

- Alumni Feedback is collected during alumni meetings & even online. The filled-in forms are sent for further action.
- The teachers or peers also give their feedback and the received data gets forwarded to the authorities for further action.
- The feedback committee collects inputs and suggestions from the students ,teachers and alumna, e further action to be taken is discussed with departments and authorities. The decisions taken by the authorities are forwarded for action to be initiated.

Analysis Report of the Students' Feedback

The following are the observation on student's feedback:

1. Course and Teaching Evaluation: -

- Course design is in coordination with current challenges.
- Majority of students agreed that the syllabus taught provides them the confidence and basic concepts for higher studies.
- Evaluation of students was also conducted fairly.
- 80% students agreed that use of information technology is effective and paper is reused there by adhering to green principles

2. Students Feedback on Teaching: -

- Teachers are well experienced about their subjects and possess excellent communication skill.
- Teachers are accessible throughout college hours and beyond.
- Teachers are very committed to imparting valuable knowledge.
- More than 70% students believe that teachers are able to generate interest through various teaching methodologies.
- Students are also encouraged for extra-curricular activities.

3. Student's Support System: -

- Students are satisfied with Library, Laboratory and infrastructure.

Analysis Report of the Teachers' Feedback

The following observations on Teachers' Feedback -

- Approximately 80% teachers feel that the course structure is at par with other government institutes. However, few suggestions were made to incorporate progressive learning oriented tools.
- Majority of the teachers believe that syllabus is competence oriented but some feel the need to include experience based projects as well as interdisciplinary topics.
- Almost 85% faculty believes that board of studies is taking care of relevance of syllabus and institution governance system is effective.
- 90% teachers feel satisfied with the encouragement they get for participating and organizing national and international seminars. Freedom to give their opinions in decision making policies is also well appreciated.









Count of 1. General communication skills


2. Rate the HOD's and Faculties overall Co-operation.




7. How do you rate NSS, NCC, Sports & Self-defense activities conducted in the college? 47 responses



8. How do you feel about the Ethical values and discipline followed have helped in making you a responsible member of society?








9. How do you rate Hostel facility provided by the college? 47 responses

Analysis Report of the Alumnae Feedback

- 90% of the respondents feel that the courses were useful for employment and entrepreneurship, course content was appropriate and relevant.
- 75% and above of alumni were highly satisfied with the overall cooperation and Career counselling from Faculties.
- Majority of alumni responded that facilities like Laboratories,
 Library and Computer literacy lab are greatly useful.
- 95% and above respondents appreciated the efforts made in activities like NCC, NSS, and Self-defence and for overall development.
- The ethical values and discipline followed by the college were highly appreciated by 90% of alumni.

Action Taken:

On the basis of the students Feed Back Analysis, the following points were reported in Governing Body meeting held on 24/4/2022:

- 1. Career and placement of students should be upgraded.
- 2. Use of Information Technology in the teaching process should be more effective.
- 3. New books on all subjects should be added to the Library.
- 4. Parking, Washroom, Canteen and Drinking Water facilities should be improved.

The Governing Body advised the Principal to take the suitable action in this regards.





Recommendation By Feedback Committee

On the basis of the students Feed Back Analysis 2022-23, the following points are reported to the administration:

- 1. Sanitary Napkin Vending machine should be installed in the institute.
- 2. Career and placement of students should be upgraded.
- 3. Use of Information Technology in the teaching process should be more effective.
- 4. Books for competitive exams should be added to the Library and lighting system should be improve.
- 5. Parking, Washroom, and Drinking Water facilities should be improved.
- 6. Hygiene should be maintained in the canteen and improve canteen food quality.
- 7. Alumni requested for more industrial visits and regular alumni meet.
- 8. Alumni suggested to design the curriculum according to the need of the job market.
- 9. Alumni felt to have more number of guest lectures and interaction from industry .
- 10. Teachers suggested allocation of credits to syllabus in the course.
- 11. Teachers also suggested job readiness capability of the syllabus.
