WHAT IS STATISTICS?

The word "statistics" has been derived from the Latin word "status" or Italian word "Statista" or German word "statistika". Each word means political state. Initially, statistics was used to collect the information of the people of the state about their income, health, illiteracy and wealth etc.

STATISTICS IN PLURAL SENSE

In plural sense, statistics refers to information in terms of numbers or numerical data such as Population statistics, Employment statistics etc.

However any numerical information is not statistics.

DEFINITION

"Statistics are numericals' statement of facts in any department of enquiry placed in relation to each other."

"By statistics we mean quantitative data affected to marked extent by multiplicity of causes."

STATISTICS IN SINGULAR SENSE

In a singular sense, statistics means science of statistics methods. It refers to techniques or methods relating to collection, classification, presentation, analysis and interpretation of quantitative data.

DEFINITION

"Statistics may be defined as the collection, presentation, analysis and interpretation of numerical data.

"Statistics is the science which deals with the collection, classification and tabulation of numerical facts as a basis for the explanation, description and comparison of phenomena.

SUBJECT MATTER OF STATISTICS

Subject matter of statistics includes two components:-

Descriptive Statistics-

It refers to those methods which are used for the collection, presentation as well as analysis of data.

These methods relate measurement of central tendencies, measurement of dispersion, measurement of correlation etc.

Accounting For Depreciation

→ What is Depreciation?

Depreciation means decrease in value of fixed assets due to their use in business, passage of time or obsolescence.

→ Depreciation as per AS 6.

- Depreciation is a measure of the wearing out, consumption or other loss of value of a depreciable asset arising from use, effluxion of time or obsolescence through technology and market changes.
- Depreciation is allocated so as to charge a fair proportion of the depreciable amount in each accounting period during the expected useful life of the asset.
- Depreciation includes amortisation of assets whose useful life is pre-determined.

Depreciable Assets.

(i) Depreciable assets are assets which are expected to be used during more than one accounting period; and

(ii) have a limited useful life; and

(iii) are held by an enterprise for use in the production or supply of goods and services, for rental to others, or for administrative purposes and not for the purpose of sale in the ordinary course of business.

What is depletion?

The term 'Depletion' refers to the physical deterioration by the exhaustion of natural resources, like, quarries, mines, oil-wells etc. Due to mining or extraction, the stock of minerals/oils etc. is depleted / reduced. In case of such assets usually depreciation is charged on the basis of quantity produced.
