The representatives of Department of Biotechnology, Institute for Excellence in Higher Education, Bhopal (M.P) and Department of Biotechnology, Zoology, Botany & Microbiology, Sri Sathya Sai College for Women (Autonomous), Bhopal (M.P) agree to this memorandum of Understanding.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) establishes the following.

1. OBJECTIVE OF THE AGREEMENT

- (A) To establish a mutually beneficial relationship built on academic and scientific cooperation.
- (B) Areas of cooperation between the Department of Biotechnology, Institute For Excellence In Higher Education, Bhopal (M.P) and Department Of Biotechnology, Zoology, Botany & Microbiology, Sri Sathya Sai College for Women (Autonomous), Bhopal (M.P) include the exchange of researchers, students, publication, academic programs and research project like PG Dissertation, UG and PG project works etc.
- (C) To conduct study tour, a mutually agreed in writing between the both departments with prior commencement of this activity.

2. GOALS AND FORMS OF COOPERATION

The signing institutions agree to provide opportunity, as appropriate, for the following activities towards the completion of the objective of this MOU.

- (A) Exchange of students and /or researchers with the objective of offering courses and realizing research projects in areas mutually agreed upon by both institutes through prior invitation and in accordance with the procedures and expectations established by each institute and specific department.
- (B) Exchange of books, scientific publications, study programs, academic projects, course information, seminars, conferences and other data and information of common interest.


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- (C) Develop joint research projects and joint publications.
- (D) Lectures of faculty members on special topics.
- (E) All joint activities will be realized through the mutual agreement and clearly established conditions and mutual obligations of the appropriate institute entity.

3. IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The objectives the MOU will be implemented and regulated in the following manner:

I. Student Exchange

- (A) Student and research scholars may visit the corresponding departments of these institutes after finalizing a mutually acceptable schedule.
- (B) All the expenses shall be the direct responsibility of the student concerned (subject to any agreements on payment arrangements made by either institution with its own students).

These expenses include:

1. Travel expenses
2. Reprographic and Internet Usage Expenses
3. Required student services fess at the host institution
4. Books and academic supplies
5. Administrative fees, if any.

II. Exchange of researchers

With the objective of strengthening ties through joint projects and research activities of both institutes, the MOU allows for the creation of researcher exchange. The following conditions will apply.

- (A) The researchers will maintain their status as research scholars at their home institution for the duration of the exchange.
- (B) The researchers will be allowed to make use of the instruments and other research facilities available at various departments of these institutes after prior approval of the visiting schedule.
- (C) The appropriate departments and administrative offices will assist in securing housing and other necessary arrangements for living in the host institutions city.

III. Research and Resources



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Department of Biotechnology, Institute For Excellence In Higher Education, Bhopal (M.P) and Department Of Biotechnology, Zoology, Botany & Microbiology, Sri Sathya Sai College for Women (Autonomous), Bhopal (M.P) agree to promote research and realize collaborative projects, giving priority to interdisciplinary works.

4. DURATION AND RECINDENCE OF MOU

- (A) The agreement will take effect from the date of its signing changes to this agreement shall be made by mutual consent between both institutions. In cases of disagreement, the Institute wishing to depart from the agreement shall, whichever possible, give two months notice of its intention to do so. The agreement shall be reviewed after a period of three years.

Memorandum of Understanding

Between

Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal

And

Miracle Information Services Private Limited, Bhopal

This Memorandum of understanding (MOU) is effective as on 30 Sept 2023 to establish an affiliation by and between career Guidance and Placement Cell of **Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, H.E. Hospital, Habibganj, Bhopal, 462024.**

And

Miracle Information Services Private Limited, Bhopal located at Plot no 80, 3rd Floor, Aakriti Complex, MP Nagar Bhopal (M.P) India, for the purpose of technical learning, Skill Development Program, Internship (with or without stipend), Industrial visit, Training and placement etc.

The aforesaid organizations are hereafter referred to individually as Organization and collectively as organizations.

Preamble

WHEREAS, **Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal** and **Miracle Information Services Private Limited, Bhopal** (aka **Miracle Infoserv**) have many areas of common interest in technical learning, Internship (with or without stipend); Industrial visit, Training and placement, considerable advances may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, education and research.

NOW THEREFORE, **Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal** and **Miracle Information Services Private Limited, Bhopal** have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MOU), which defines the frame work for the cooperation of the two organizations set out in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

Both organizations agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest on the basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two organizations shall seek to promote

a. Technical Learning

- i. To learn technical skills and understand technology.
- ii. To arrange sessions on technical trainings/Internships.

b. Placements

- i. To Support in placement activities for eligible students.
- ii. To provide internship opportunity for eligible students

c. Skill Development Programs

- i. To organize Skill development programs
- ii. To create ample opportunities for the students to learn and grow in desired skills.
- iii. To jointly organize seminars/GD's/ Live projects/workshops/training activities etc. for the students.

ARTICLE 2: SCOPE OF THE MOU

2.1 MOU Between **Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal** & **Miracle Information Services Private Limited** on the basis of that second party will provide Training/Internship/expert lecture/workshop/seminars to the student of first party.

2.2 There is no financial commitment on the part of the **Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal**, the first party to take up any program mention in MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

2.3 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required.

ARTICLE 3: COORDINATION

Either organization shall appoint one member to coordinate the program on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a program coordinator from the side of **Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal** and a program coordinator from the side of **Miracle Information Services Private Limited, Bhopal** will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two organizations.

ARTICLE 4: VALIDITY

The MoU shall remain in force for a period of **THREE** years commencing from 30th sept 2023. Organizations may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

ARTICLE 5: TERMINATION

Either organization may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of three months in advance to the other organization. Once terminated, neither **Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal** nor **Miracle Information Services Private Limited, Bhopal** will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other organizations may suffer.

However, **Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal** and **Miracle Information Services Private Limited, Bhopal** will ensure that the provisions of this MOU shall continue to apply to all activities in progress until their completion.

ARTICLE 6: AMENDMENTS / MODIFICATIONS

This MOU may be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both organizations.

ARTICLE 7: ADHERENCE TO LAWS

Participating students involved in any activities under this MOU must adhere to rules and regulations of the organizations and the law of the country.

ARTICLE 8: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this MOU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the organizations. This MOU is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

ARTICLE 9: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case of any dispute in any matter Vice President **Miracle Information Services Private Limited, Bhopal** and Principal **Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal** will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.

Bhopal birds conservation society is a well-established non-government organisation which was registered under M.P Society registration act 1973. The Society is based in Bhopal and working all over India. It is a group of dedicated and enthusiastic researcher, birder and conservationist. It is mainly concerned with conservation of birds and biodiversity, It plays multitasking role in conservation of biodiversity through research, awareness, conservation actions, digital documentation of avian species, publication etc.

BACKGROUND OF PARTIES

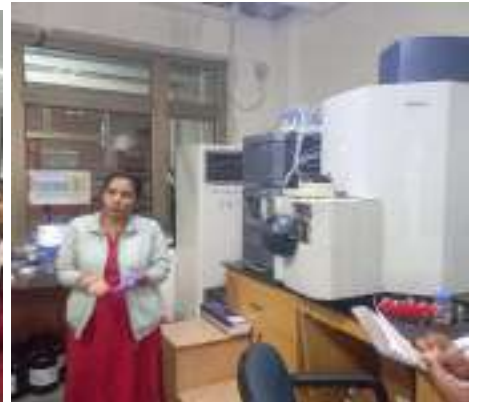
The objective of the visit is to promote research activities and to provide students with valuable opportunities to engage in science education and research activities.
