### **Progress Report for the Session 2019-20**

Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal was founded by no less a person than our founder President Bhagwan Sri Sathya Sai Baba on 4th July 1974, a Guru Purnima day. It received the sanction from the M.P. Uchcha Shiksha Anudan Ayog in 1974, (Letter No. S/II/Affl/74/10069dated 19.11.74) as an institution affiliated to the Barkatullah University (Letter No. 23935/Acad/Affl./74 dated 23.12.74), and was later recognized by UGC, New Delhi under 2(f) and 12 (B), [Vide letter No. F. 8- 14/78 (C.P.) dated. 27.03.82 and F 8 - 259/2003(CPP-i) dated 4.02.2004]. Since its inception, the College has maintained its disposition as a center for all-round education based on discipline, duty, devotion, innovative teaching, informed and engaging research.

Currently College offers 20 subjects at UG level in four faculties and 9 subjects in PG courses English, Hindi, viz Mathematics, Political Science, Zoology, Biotechnology, Computer Science, Chemistry and Commerce. We also offer integrated dual Degree in B.A.L.L.B. and professional degrees of L.L.B., B.Ed. and B.C.A. College publishes its biannual research journal "Highbrow" with ISSN number and college magazine "Divya" to nurture the budding talents of the institution. College also has an in-campus hostel with all facilities for its 108 inmates and a rich library with 36,600 plus books, e-journals and e-books through Inflibnet, sports complex with gymnasium and separate activity center. The college has continually registered nearly 100% pass result in the examination from the last 44 plus years. 68% teachers of the college have been conferred with Ph.D. Degree. Many teachers have attended National and International conferences/seminar/workshop over the years and published more than 400 research papers in the last five years.

We are highly indebted to **NAAC** Peer Team for examining our systems and validating our claims in our re-accreditation process for which we received "**A" Grade in the year 2015**. In our quest for excellence, Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college applied for autonomous status of the institution to UGC, New Delhi and subsequently college was granted Autonomous status for ten years from the session 2018-19 by UGC in December 2017 (Letter No. F.22-1/2017(AC) dated 28.12.2017) for all programs run under auspices of UGC. Subsequent to the approval by UGC we applied for NOC from department of Higher Education, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh and same was conferred to us vide there letter No. 466/484/2018/38-3 dated- 24.05.2018. After an inspection by a special committee constituted by Barkatullah University, Bhopal the Autonomous status was conferred to us for 10 years under University Statue 36 vide their letter No. 2432/Academy/Sambadhta/2018 dated - 13.07.2018. After obtaining all necessary sanction and approval we commenced requisite process and procedure as laid down by the UGC guidelines 2018 for establishing the Autonomous Cell of the college. Autonomy facilitates an academic freedom that the college can formulate its own syllabus for all UG and PG courses, starting from the academic year 2018-19 and carries out the assessments also. The Examination Cell therefore, has been restructured to carry out all the examination activities. The Examination Cell of the college is a confidential section with the responsibility of conduction of examinations both internal and external, evaluation, publication and display of results, maintenance of student records for all UGC approved courses offered by the college which falls under the preview of Autonomy. Apart from central examination system every department has departmental examination committee comprising HOD and Examination Coordinators for each year. The examination cell is restructured as

Last year, being the first of establishment of Autonomous Cell, the Board of Studies of all the 18 subjects in the faculty of Arts, Science, Commerce and Computer Science & Application were constituted as per the UGC guidelines. Academic council, finance committee and Governing Body Council were also constituted. Barkatullah University has nominated their members for all the committees in line with the guidelines of the University. In every Board of Studies, one nominee from Barkatullah University (Vide letter No. 3054/Academy/2018 dated-25.09.2018), one member from other university, head of the department of the concerned subject and all faculty members of the department were the members. One representative from industry/corporate sector/ allied area relating to placement and one meritorious alumna of the department were nominated by the Principal. Two subject experts were nominated by the Academic Council of the college. As the tenure of all the committees is of three years hence the same committees with little modifications were in force for the present session.

Meetings of all the 18 Board of Studies were convened during the last week of June, 19. It was decided and conveyed by the BOS that the syllabus of Central Board of Studies as approved by Barkatullah University will be followed for the first year of Autonomy. The examination pattern and the marking scheme in each subjects of UG first year & PG first and second semester will be the same as that of Barkatullah University.

The meeting of the Academic Council was held on 26.6.2019. The academic council approved the minutes of the Board of Studies meetings. Academic council decided that during the second year the first CCE(Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation) examination, in the month of Sep,19, will continue to be "Non Traditional" and second CCE will be of "Traditional mode" in the month of Jan'20 for the year 2019-20 in PG/UG I and II year . Academic calendar for the session 2019-20 was also approved. It was reiterated that the question paper of PG II and IV semester and UG II yr courses will have a prototype of 3 section of objective type, short answer and long answer as practiced in PG I & III Sem and UG I yr courses during the 2018-19 session.

As decided and approved by the academic council, College started **certificate course** for 3 months duration in the department of Music. The "Sugam Sangeet", "Shartriya Sangeet" and "Vaadan Harmoniyam" classes attracted 52 students this year. Apart from various cultural, academic, extracurricular activities and extension activities in adopted village "Chota Teela Kheda" and with various NGO's of Bhopal by all the departments of the college, some activities are worth mentioning here.

- 1. IQAC and Law department of the college organised a one day **District level seminar on** "**Recent Trends in IPR (Intellectual Property Rights)**" **on 15.10.2019.** Experts from the various organization working in the field of IPR and research were invited and it was attended by 172 students and teachers of the college.
- 2. One day college level "**Terrarium Workshop**" and "**Vegetative Propogation Workshop**" was organised by department of Botany on 4.12.19 and 7.12.19 respectively. Experts shared the technical knowhow on terrarium making and vegetative propagation in Dhanvantri medicinal Park.
- 3. Two days **National Seminar on "Role of Fundamental Duties in Sustainable Development and Nation Building"** was organised by the college on 17-18<sup>th</sup> Jan'20. It was attended by around 180 participants and experts from various parts of India delivered their expert lectures. Around 50 papers were presented during this seminar and the proceedings were published in book form.
- 4. IQAC Cell and Science faculty of the college organised a two days **National Workshop on** ""**Research Methodology in Physical and Biological Sciences**" on 10-11<sup>th</sup> Feb'20. The experts and scientist from BARC Trombay, ICAR Mumbai, NIT Surat, Amity University Kolkatta, JKLU Jaipur, AMPRI Bhopal, MANIT Bhopal, IISER Bhopal, NLIU Bhopal, EPCO Bhopal, MSCST Bhopal and Barkatullah University shared their expertise and knowledge with the participants. Around 170 faculty, research scholars and students attended this workshop.
- 5. Seven day program on "Capacity Building" was organised by the Autonomous Cell for the teachers of the college from 12th 19th Feb'20.
- 6. Two days workshop was organised for preparing **Question Bank for the PG courses** of the college in Feb'20, All the PG departments participated with the external experts from various colleges of Bhopal.
- 7. Five days **Orientation and Re-training program on "Recent Advancements in Computer Science"** was organised by Computer Science and Application department of the college from 24th to 28th Feb'20.
- 8. **Workshop on "Examination Reforms"** was organised by the Autonomous Cell on 26.2.20. Experts from various colleges of Bhopal delivered their lectures on the topic.

Autonomous cell was upgraded and strengthened with the purchase of required furniture, computers, photocopier, establishment of IT Cell and hiring some services of

technical experts. Autonomous Examination Cell conducted the semester examination for PG I & III sem in the month of Dec 2019 in eight subjects with 35 papers. The examination process began with examination form submission by students in the month of Nov 2018. Exam were conducted from 15 days (14.12.2019-28.12.2019). The examination pattern of Barkatullah University was followed for the whole process of PG examination. The TR and marksheets were sent to Barkatullah University for validation and signature of Registrar, Barkatullah University. A meeting of examination committee was convened to discuss the result and the result was declared 31.01.2019 through the college website. The whole process of PG examination from declaration of time table to the declaration of result was completed in less than 75 days.

Further a meeting of finance committee was held on 29.4.19 and 21. 5. 20, the committee reviewed the budget for the session 2019-20 for examination related expenditure and grant for other heads. Honourable members approved the proposed budget. The committee also instructed that all the expenditure should be made as per the rules of Govt. of Madhya Pradesh (M.P. Bhandar Kray Niyam Tatha Seva Uparjan Niyam 2015). UGC, New Delhi released the Autonomous grant for the year 2019-20 and reimbursement of expenditure of the 2018-19 in the month of Dec' 19.

A meeting of Governing Body Council was held on 30.4.19 and 22.5.20. The council approved the minutes of the Boards of Studies of the 18 subjects after scrutiny. The minutes of academic council and finance committee were approved. The Governing Body was informed that the MIS module developed for the examination cell of the Autonomous cell, is in the final stage of its implementation. MIS system is storing the information of all the students admitted to the courses under the preview of the Autonomous scheme, examination details, TR sheets, Mark sheets etc.

The process for PG II and IV semester and UG I & II yr examination was started on 28th Jan and students of UG classes and PG classes filled the examination forms till 16th March' 20. Due to unforeseen circumstances of COVID 19, the exams will be held in UG and PG classes as per the Government directives at the earliest possible dates. Teachers completed the syllabus of UG/PG classes through online mode after nationwide lockdown post 22th March '20.

On Guru Purnima,04 July 1974 Bhagwan Sri Sathya Sai Baba founded Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal. Sanction from M.P. Uccha Shiksha Anudan Ayog was received in 1974, vide (Letter No. S/II/Affl/74/10069 dated 19.11.74) as an institution affiliated to the Barkatullah University (Letter No. 23935/Acad/Affl./74 dated 23.12.74). The institution was recognized by UGC, New Delhi under 2(f) and 12 (B), Vide letter No. F8- 14/78 (C.P.) dated. 27.03.82 and F-8 - 259/2003(CPP-i) dated 4.02.2004. Ever Since its inception, the institution has been committed to female education and emancipation our focus is on all-around development of learners through value-based education, innovative teaching, and engaging research.

Presently the College offers 20 subjects at UG level in four faculties - B.A., B.Sc., B.Com, and BCA. 9 subjects in PG courses viz. English, Hindi, Mathematics, PoliticalScience, Zoology, Biotechnology, Computer Science, Chemistry and Commerce. We also offer integrated dual Degrees in B.A.L.L.B. and professional degrees of L.L.B., B.Ed. and B.C.A. The institution has an in-campus hostel which can house 108 inmates. We have a fully computerized rich central library with 36,600 plus books, e-journals, and e-books through Inflibnet. Most of our teachers hold Ph.D. degrees and are engaged actively in research. Our teachers participate in National and International conferences and seminars and have published research papers in national and international journals. The College publishes its biannual multidisciplinary research journal **Highbrow** with an ISSN number. College magazine "Divya" is published annually, providing a platform to our budding talents to showcase their creativity.

The institution applied to UGC, New Delhi for Autonomous status, which was granted for 10 years in December 2017, effective from the session 2018-19 (Letter No. F.22-1/2017(AC) dated 28.12.2017) for all programs run under UGC. Approval for the same was granted by the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Madhya vide letter No. 466/484/2018/38-3 dated 24.05.2018. The Inspection Committee from Barkatullah University also inspected our documents and infrastructural resources and approved our Autonomous status 10 years under University Statute 36 vide letter No. 2432/Academy/Sambadhta/2018 dated 13.07.2018. Having obtained all required sanctions and approval, the Autonomous Cell of the college was established as per UGC guidelines in 2018.

Despite the pandemic and the consequent lockdown our teaching and learning went on uninterrupted through our online classes, Webinars, Workshops, training programs, lecture series, orientation programmes, and extension activities. A complete list of all such activities is attached separately......

The Autonomous cell organized a 7-day **Faculty Development Programme**- Capacity Building for Teachers from 1.3.2021 to 9.3.2021. Expert speakers were invited to deliver lectures on a variety of topics ranging from the New Education Policy, NAAC revised framework, Best practices, and Emotional Quotient, to Online learning tools and Yoga and Meditation.

From July 2020 to January 2021 several Webinars were conducted on variedtopics for both students and teachers. The IQAC in collaboration with different departments conducted various activities, workshops, and lectures in February 2021. Both students and teachers were benefitted.

Under the UGC Autonomous Scheme-**Development of Area, Study Programmes** were conducted at Village Tola Chota Kheda, Panchayat Kalapani District Bhopal. This village has been adopted by our College. A one-day camp was organized in the village on 17.3.2021 by the students and teachers of the Home Science Department. A lecture was delivered on Health, Hygiene, and Nutrition at the Anganwadi centre in the village of Chota Kheda.Dr. Shubha Kapdeo, HOD of Home Science, addressed the students and women of the village and elaborated upon the guidelines of Covid 19 pandemic and the norms of social distancing. She emphasized on the importance of a nutritious diet for maintaining good health and developing a good immune system.

Dr. Malti Joshi apprised the villagers about the importance of a nutrition garden for the enhancement of nutritional status and immunity of family members. Saplings of fruits and vegetables were distributed to women and children in the Aanganwadi center. They were also taught to plant fruit and vegetable saplings in their nutrition garden. Before concludingthe camp, biscuits and fruits were distributed to all children and women who participated in the camp.

**Question Bank Workshop** was organized by the Autonomous Cell for all subjects in Feb 2021. Subject experts were invited from different institutions to prepare question papers for PG III sem.

Under the Autonomous Scheme of UGC, some **Extension activities** were also organised-

- 1. 22.02.2021 **Programme on Health & Hygiene awareness** conducted in Sri Sathya Sai Girls School, Piplani by Dept. of Home Science, Sociology, Education and IQAC, Dr. Pradnya Kapdeo addressed the students virtually about menstrual hygiene and sanitation. Lectures were also delivered on the psychological aspect of the menstrual cycle, Cleanliness & hygiene in the COVID phase. They were also made aware of the use of Sanitary napkins & cleanliness.
- 2. 10.03.2021- **Programmes on Cleanliness/Art & Creativity**. NSS volunteers and students from all faculties went to Bal Kalyan & Bal Sahitya & Shodh Kendra. Students were given drawing and coloring material and taught to make use of them to encourage creativity.
- 3. 16.03.2021- As an expression of gratitude to senior citizens, students & Teachers visited the Old Age Home and spent time interacting with the inmates. Fruits, biscuits, towels & soap were distributed.

### **Examination Cell**

This is a significant part of the Autonomous Cell. It is a confidential section responsible for conducting examinations both internal and external, evaluation, publication and display of results, and maintenance of students' records for all UGC-approved courses falling under the purview of autonomy. The Examination Cell formed in 2018 will remain the same up to session 2020-21 ie. the current session (3 yrs term) Due to the pandemic and its consequent lockdown, the examination could not be conducted for the session 2019-2020, as per the directives of the Department of Higher Education, Govt. Of M.P. and Barkatullah University, students of UG I & II and PG II were granted general promotion. Students of UG III and PG IV took the openbook exam.

The admission process for sessions 2020-21 commenced in July 2020. Since admissions were delayed the session was also delayed. Since lockdown continued we were instructed to take online classes for all courses. Meetings of the Board of Studies for all subjects were held in November 2020. It was agreed upon for all subjects that the syllabus prescribed by the Central Board of Studies and approved by Barkatullah University in the previous session will be continued in this session also. The Examination pattern and mark scheme will also remain the same.

Examination for the odd semesters of PG courses could not be conducted. Students were promoted to the next semester based on CCE marks. For session 2020-21 again, owing to the COVID-19 pandemic, directives from Higher Education have been received.

UG I & II and PG II of all subjects will be examined by the open book system. UG III and PG sem IV will take offline exams in the paper pen mode in June 2021.

The meeting of the **Academic Council** was held on 9.12.2020. Academic Calendar for the session was presented and approved. This session owing to the pandemic, online classes were conducted for all UG and PG courses, and study materials were posted online. Generally, two CCEs are held in each session. The first CCE was taken in the non-traditional mode for which students were given MCQs and assignments which they had to submit and were marked on them. The second CCE was held in the Traditional mode- students had to take offline tests in pen mode. Their papers were evaluated and marked. It was decided that for all subjects at UG & PG levels, a certain pattern of question papers will be followed. The paper will be in three sections – Objective questions, Short answers, and Long answers. PG Sem IV will have an oriented Project of 100 Marks.

The Principal welcomed Smt—Jyoti Goliath and all members were present in the meeting.

At the outset, it was conveyed that since the College was granted Autonomous Status the finance committee was constituted as per UGC guidelines for a term of 3 years.

The main points discussed were as follows:-

- 1. The grant to be received in the session 2020-21 was Rs. 15,00,000/- against which an actual expenditure of Rs. 15,04,216/- was incurred in the session. In the financial year 2021-22 ie. the next session also a grant of Rs. 15,00,000/- is expected from UGC, Delhi. Accordingly, an expenditure of Rupees fifteen lakh on various heads approved by UGC has been planned. A report of the actual income and expenditure of the session 2020-21 was presented and approved. For the session 2021-22, a budget with estimated income and expenditure was presented.
- 2. As per the guidelines of UGC, in the session 2020-21, an expenditure of Rs. 15,04,216/- was made and different heads approved by UGC. A utilization certificate, duly signed and certified by a CA will be sent to the Regional UGC office, Bhopal along with the other required documents. Since a grant for the session has not been received so far money for expenditure had to be borrowed from the Management. A letter regarding the release of the grant and reimbursement of actual expenditure incurred in the session 2020-21 is to be sent to UGC, Delhi.
- 3. It was conveyed that in the academic session 2020-21 (1 July 2020 to 30 June 2021), the estimated income from examination and other fees would be Rs. 16,70,000/-—an estimated expenditure of Rupees. 15,80,000/- was proposed. In the session, the actual income was Rs. 15,97,779/- and the expenditure was made accordingly. For the session 2021-22 (01 July 2021 to 30 June 2022) a budget was proposed based on estimated income and expenditure.
- 4. It was proposed that three staff members from the IT cell, who are working for the autonomous cell be paid Rs. 400/- per month for their services in the autonomous cell.

The meeting of the **Governing Body** was held on 12.04.2021. This was a sessionending meeting to review the working of the Autonomous Cell in the session 2020-21 and toplan for the session 2021-22. The meeting was held virtually on Google Meet. The following members were present:

### **Progress Report for the Session 2021-22**

On 04 July 1974 Guru Purnima, Bhagwan Sri Sathya Sai Baba founded Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal. Sanction from M.P. Uccha Shiksha Anudan Ayog was received in 1974, vide (Letter No. S/II/Affl/74/10069 dated 19.11.74) as an institution affiliated to the Barkatullah University (Letter No. 23935/Acad/Affl./74 dated 23.12.74). The institution was recognized by UGC, New Delhi under 2(f) and 12 (B), Vide letter No. F8- 14/78 (C.P.) dated. 27.03.82 and F-8 - 259/2003(CPP-i) dated 4.02.2004. Ever Since its inception, the institution has been committed to female education and emancipation our focus is on the all-round development of learners through value-based education, innovative teaching, and engaging research.

At present, the College offers 20 subjects at UG level in four faculties - B.A., B.Sc., B.Com, and BCA. 9 subjects in PG courses viz. English, Hindi, Mathematics, PoliticalScience, Zoology, Biotechnology, Computer Science, Chemistry, and Commerce. We also offer integrated dual Degrees in B.A.L.L.B. and professional degrees of L.L.B., B.Ed. and B.C.A. The institution has an in-campus hostel that can house 108 inmates. We have a fully computerized rich central library with 36,600 plus books, e-journals, and e-books through Inflibnet. Most of our teachers hold Ph.D. degrees and are engaged actively in research. Our teachers participate in National and International conferences and seminars and have published research papers in national and international journals. The College publishes its biannual multidisciplinary research journal **Highbrow** with an ISSN number. College magazine "Divya" is published annually, providing a platform for our budding talents to showcase their creativity.

The institution applied to UGC, New Delhi for Autonomous status, which was granted for 10 years in December 2017, effective from the session 2018-19 (Letter No. F.22-1/2017(AC) dated 28.12.2017) for all programs run under UGC. Approval for the same was granted by the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Madhya vide letter No. 466/484/2018/38-3 dated 24.05.2018. The Inspection Committee from Barkatullah University also inspected our documents and infrastructural resources and approved of our Autonomous status for years under University vide letter 10 Statute No. 2432/Academy/Sambadhta/2018 dated 13.07.2018. Having obtained all required sanctions and approval, the Autonomous Cell of the college was established as per UGC guidelines in 2018.
