BACKGROUND OF PARTIES

Bhopal birds conservation society is a well-established non-government organisation which was registered under M.P Society registration act 1973. The Society is based in Bhopal and working all over India. It is a group of dedicated and enthusiastic researcher, birder and conservationist. It is mainly concerned with conservation of birds and biodiversity, It plays multitasking role in conservation of biodiversity through research, awareness, conservation actions, digital documentation of avian species, publication etc.

BACKGROUND OF PARTIES

Department of Zoology and Biotechnology, Sri Sathya Sai (Autonomous) College for Women, Bhopal, is unique amongst the various colleges of Bhopal as it was founded by the grace of Bhagwan Sri Sathya Sai Baba himself on the auspicious day of Guru Purnima (4th July 1974). We are highly indebted to NAAC Peer team for examining our systems and validating our claims in our re-accreditation process for which we received 'A' Grade in the year 2015.

Currently college offers 21 subjects, at undergraduate level in four faculties (Arts, Science, Commerce, Comp. Sci. and Comp. Application) and 8 postgraduate courses (Hindi, English, Political Sci., Mathematics, Comp. Sci., Zoology, Biotechnology, Chemistry and Commerce). We also offer integrated dual Degree in B.A.L.L.B. and professional degree B. Ed. BCA and L.L.B.. College publishes its bianpual research journal "Highbrow". The number of faculty members are engaged either as Ph.D. supervisors or in UGC, DBT, DST-FIST etc. sponsored major and minor research projects. College also has an in-campus hostel with all facilities for its 108 inmates and a rich library with 36,600 plus books, e-journals and e-books through Infilbnet, sports complex with gymnasium and separate activity center. The college has continually registered nearly 100% pass result in the examination from the last

46 plus years. 68% teachers of the college have been conferred with Ph.D. degree. Many teachers have been attended National and International conferences/seminars/workshop over the years and published more than 500 research papers in the last five years.

PURPOSE

The Parties recognize the benefits to be derived for increased collaboration, cooperation and interaction for the purpose of promotion and understanding of high performance in awareness activities and organizing various programmes including workshops, conferences, and other awareness activities. The purpose of this MoU is to define the areas for fundamental, socio academic aspects in which the Parties desire to work together in the future for their mutual benefits to foster a collaborative frame work between Bhopal Birds Conservation Society and Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal in the field with a view to benefiting from each other's natives and working procedures and support collaboration among the members associated with both parties.

SCOPE

If the Parties later agree to undertake specific joint projects with legally binding obligations, they will develop separate written agreements for such projects setting out each Party's contributions, deliverables.

- Collaboration in awareness campaigns and other field of mutual interest.
- Provide free of cost mutual access to facilities available for purpose of Awareness Programs.

This MoU is signed between Bhopal Birds Conservation Society and Department of Zoology and Biotechnology, Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal for the Academic year 2022-24 for following deliverables.

Deliverables from the Bhopal Birds Conservation Society

1. Collaborate in organizing activities related to environmental protection and conservation.
2. Providing platform to our students to undergo short term biodiversity conservation courses under Bhopal Birds Conservation Society.
3. Organizing events for awareness and conservation of biodiversity in our college and promote the activities through various media platforms

Deliverables from the Department of Zoology and Biotechnology, Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal

1. The Institution will allow Bhopal Birds Conservation Society to organise various awareness programs on biodiversity conservation in the campus and also provide basic infrastructure free of cost.
2. Motivate students to undergo various campaign and awareness program organized by Bhopal Birds Conservation Society.
3. Logo on all online and offline modes of promotion of the event jointly organized by the Institution and Bhopal Birds Conservation Society.

MODE OF OPERATION

Both parties will provide necessary support for effective implementation of the MoU within the institutional rules and procedures.

This MoU shall be effective from the date it is signed by both the parties.

Within the broad frame work of the MoU, Bhopal Birds Conservation Society, Bhopal and Department of Zoology and Biotechnology, Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal can work on awareness and conservation activities, Short Term Courses on Biodiversity Conservation.

Any financial commitment for joint activities under this MoU shall be subject to the approval by the Competent Authorities of the respective organizations.

The activities under this MoU shall be coordinated, monitored and recorded by an Internal Coordination Committee President, Bhopal Birds Conservation Society, shall be the internal coordinator from Bhopal Birds Conservation Society whereas The Principal of Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal, will be the internal coordinator from Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal. The visitors will be bound by the rules and regulations, as well as the code of conduct at the host institution.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

This MoU places no financial obligations or supplementary funding commitments on either party. These activities will be defined through separate programme agreements, detailing the cost of resources (Financial or Otherwise) required from each institution. Subsequent program agreements must be approved in advance in writing by the authorized representatives from both Parties. Each Party will be responsible for its own costs in connections with all matters relating to collaborations under this MoU. Where possible and appropriate, the parties may also seek funding for collaborations from Government and related agencies.




VALIDITY

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



**Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of understanding (MOU) is effective as on 30 Sept 2023 to establish an affiliation by and between career Guidance and Placement Cell of **Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, H.E. Hospital, Habibganj, Bhopal, 462024.**

And

Miracle Information Services Private Limited, Bhopal located at Plot no 80, 3rd Floor, Aakriti Complex, MP Nagar Bhopal (M.P) India, for the purpose of technical learning, Skill Development Program, Internship (with or without stipend), Industrial visit, Training and placement etc.

The aforesaid organizations are hereafter referred to individually as Organization and collectively as organizations.

Preamble

WHEREAS, **Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal** and **Miracle Information Services Private Limited, Bhopal** (aka **Miracle Infoserv**) have many areas of common interest in technical learning, Internship (with or without stipend); Industrial visit, Training and placement, considerable advances may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, education and research.

NOW THEREFORE, **Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal** and **Miracle Information Services Private Limited, Bhopal** have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MOU), which defines the frame work for the cooperation of the two organizations set out in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

Both organizations agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest on the basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two organizations shall seek to promote

a. Technical Learning

- i. To learn technical skills and understand technology.
- ii. To arrange sessions on technical trainings/Internships.

b. Placements

- i. To Support in placement activities for eligible students.
- ii. To provide internship opportunity for eligible students

c. Skill Development Programs

- i. To organize Skill development programs
- ii. To create ample opportunities for the students to learn and grow in desired skills.
- iii. To jointly organize seminars/GD's/ Live projects/workshops/training activities etc. for the students.

ARTICLE 2: SCOPE OF THE MOU

2.1 MOU Between **Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal** & **Miracle Information Services Private Limited** on the basis of that second party will provide Training/Internship/expert lecture/workshop/seminars to the student of first party.

2.2 There is no financial commitment on the part of the **Sri Sathya Sai College for Women, Bhopal**, the first party to take up any program mention in MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.




